



## **For Allentown Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine Patients Who Have Tested POSITIVE for COVID-19**

Once you have been tested for COVID-19 disease you must **Isolate** until you have received your test results. **This is mandated by the Erie County Department of Health.** Household members and close contacts should self-quarantine while waiting for test results.

Please follow the Erie County Department of Health guidance for continued **mandatory isolation** if you test **positive** for COVID-19. Household members and close contacts are **mandated to Quarantine** for 14 days from the time of the last exposure to the positive COVID-19 person.

Refer to the Erie County Department of Health website for details regarding the most current isolation and quarantine requirements. Please answer any calls from ECDOH contact tracers. Please advise all household members and close contacts to start mandatory quarantine.

Allentown Providers will be checking in with you on a regular basis and are available if you have questions.
